



The Toni Beanie



Yarn: Karamell from Falkgarn

Materials: ap. 1/2 ball in the color Lime

Hook: 5 mm

Abbreviations:

sl st – slip stitch

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

hdc – half double crochet

bl – back loop (crochet in back loop only)

Measurments

Height: 30 cm/11,8 in

Width: 25 cm/9,8 in

Height before decreasing: 23 cm/9 in



Start with the ribbing

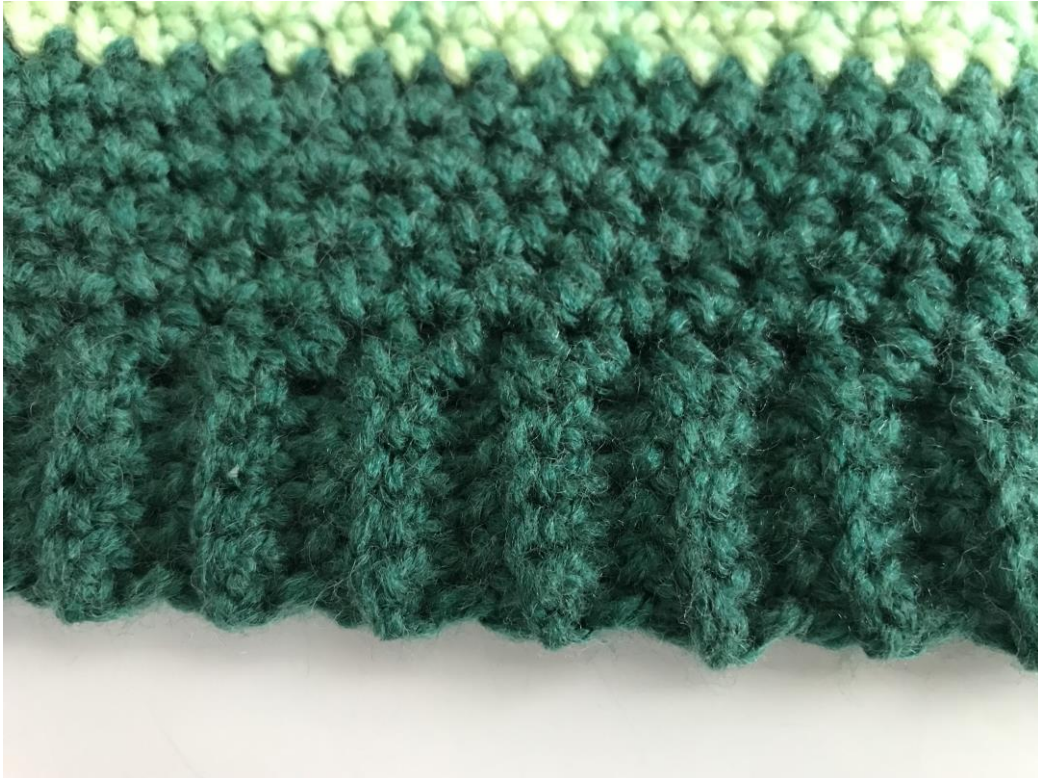
Crochet the ribbing back and forth by turning after the last sc on every row.

Row 1: ch 6, 1 sc in the second ch from the hook and in the rest of the chains (5 sc)

Row 2: ch 1, 1 sc in back loops only throughout the row (5 sc)

Keep crocheting like row 2 until you reach the length you want and for the ribbing to reach around the head. I crocheted 68 rows (52 cm or 20,5 inch). Join both ends and the ribbing should look like a ring.

DO NOT CUT THE YARN!



The beanie

Keep the beanies outside towards you while crocheting the beanie. Start crocheting from where you left off with the joining.

Round 1: ch 2, 1 hdc in each row of the ribbing. Join the round with a sl st in the 2nd ch in the beginning of the round.

Round 2: ch 2, 1 hdc in each hdc from the round before. Join the round with a sl st in the 2nd ch in the beginning of the round.

Keep crocheting like round 2 until you reach the height you want. I crocheted 23 rounds (23 cm or 9 inch, ribbing included).

Time to start decreasing

Try to decrease the first round so you'll get a stitch count that can be divided with the number 6. My beanie had 68 stitches which meant that I had to decrease 8 times to reach 60 stitches. Try to arrange the decreasing evenly as you can.

Decrease by crocheting 2 hdc together.

Decreasing round by round:

60 stitches: ch 2, 7 hdc, 2 hdc together, *8 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (54 stitches)

54 stitches: ch 2, 6 hdc, 2 hdc together, *7 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (48 stitches)

48 stitches: ch 2, 5 hdc, 2 hdc together, *6 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (42 stitches)

42 stitches: ch 2, 4 hdc, 2 hdc together, *5 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (36 stitches)

36 stitches: ch 2, 3 hdc, 2 hdc together, *4 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (30 stitches)

30 stitches: ch 2, 2 hdc, 2 hdc together, *3 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (24 stitches)

24 stitches: ch 2, 1 hdc, 2 hdc together, *2 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (18 stitches)

18 stitches: ch 2, 2 hdc together, *1 hdc, 2 hdc together * the rest of the round (12 stitches)

12 stitches: ch 2 together with 1 hdc, *2 hdc together* the rest of the round (6 stitches)

Join each round with a sl st in the 2nd ch in the beginning of the round.

Weave in your ends and you have a new beanie.
