

Tube scarf and headband



Yarn: Karamell from Falkgarn

Materials: 1 skein, I used the color Viol

Crochet hook: 5 mm

Abbreviations

sl st – slip stitch

ch – chain

sc - single crochet

dc – double crochet

V-st – V-stitch: *dc, ch 1, dc in the same stitch*

bp dc – back post double crochet: *instead of crocheting in the stitch you usually crochet in you're going to crochet around the dc in the previous row. Since this is a <u>bp dc</u> you're going to go around the dc from the <u>back</u>.*

fp dc – front post double crochet: *instead of crocheting in the stitch you usually crochet in you're going to crochet around the dc in the previous row. Since this is a <u>fp dc</u> you're going to go around the dc from the <u>front</u>.*

pst – puff stitch: pick up your thread, put the hook into the stitch and pick up the thread again and pull through the stitch. DON'T pull the thread through the loops on your hook. Repeat two times more until you have seven loops on your hook. Pull through all loops now and finish the puff stitch with ch 1. **bst**— hobble stitch: pick up your thread, but the hook into the stitch and pick up the thread again and

bst– bobble stitch: pick up your thread, put the hook into the stitch and pick up the thread again and pull through the stitch. Pick up your yarn and pull it through the first two loops on your hook. Repeat three more times until you have 5 loops on your hook then pull the thread through all of them.

lalala: repeat until you reach the end of the row or round.

Tube scarf

You crochet your scarf by turning your work at the end of every row. The first ch 3 on almost every row counts as the first dc. You crochet around the ch 3 in the previous row on your last stitch of the row if the pattern don't say otherwise.

The measurements are $130 \times 15 \text{ cm}$ (ap. $51 \times 6 \text{ in}$). If you want to change the size of you scarf, add or remove x 3 chains when you start your work.

Row 1: ch 26, start in the second ch from the hook and make 1 sc in each ch (25 sc)



Row 2: ch 3, *skip two and make a dc in the third stitch, ch 2, 1 pst in the same stitch as you made the dc to the right, ch 1* repeat through all the row, finish the row with 1 dc (8 pst)



Row 3: ch 3, *2 dc around the ch 2 on top of the pst in the previous row, 1 dc around the stitch between the "puffs" (25 dc)



Row 4: ch 3, 1 fr dc around each dc in the previous row starting in the second dc (25 fp dc)



Row 5: Repeat row 2



Row 6: repeat row 3

Row 7: ch 3, *skip en stitch and make a V-st in the next one*, finish the row with a dc.(11 V-st) **Row 8:** ch 1, 1 sc in the first stitch, *1 bst around the ch in the V-stitch, 1 sc around next two dc from the previous row*, finish the row with 1 sc.





Row 9: ch 4, 1 dc in the same stitch, *skip on stitch and make 1 V-st in the next stitch*, finish the row with a V-st in the last sc (12 V-st)

Row 10: ch 3, 2 dc around every ch 1 in V-st (25 dc)

Row 11: repeat row 2 Row 12: repeat row 3

Row 13: ch 3, bp st around each dc in the previous row starting in the second dc (25 bp dc)



Repeat row 2-13 until you reach the size you want.



I repeated the rows 8 times and that made my work 130 cm long. Crochet your short ends together by making sc in every stitch in both ends at the samt time. Make sure that work isn't twisted in any way when you crochet your ends together. Weave in ends and you have a new tube scarf.



Headhand

You crochet your headband by crocheting in rounds.

The headbands size is 55×9 cm (ap. $22,5 \times 3,5$ in) . If you want to change the size of your headband you do so by adding or removing $\times 3$ ch when you start your work.

Round 1: ch 75, close your circle with a sl st in the first ch, 1 sc in each ch (75 sc)

Round 2: ch 3, *skip two and make a dc in the third stitch, ch 2, 1 pst in the same stitch as you made the dc to the right, ch 1* before crocheting the last pst of the round, crochet the last dc in the same stitch as you made your first pst in. (25 pst)

Round 3: ch 3, *2 dc around the ch 2 on top of the pst in the previous round, 1 dc around the stitch between the "puffs" (75 dc)

Round 4: ch 3, bp st around each dc in the previous row starting in the second dc (75 bp dc)

Round 5: Turn and crochet in the opposite direction! ch 3, *skip two and make a dc in the third stitch, ch 2, 1 pst in the same stitch as you made the dc to the right, ch 1* before crocheting the last pst of the round, crochet the last dc in the same stitch as you made your first pst in. (25 pst)

Round 6: repeat round 3
Round 7: repeat round 4
Round 8: repeat round 2

Round 9: ch 1, *1 sc around the stitch between the pst, 2 sc around the ch 2 on top of the pst* (75 sc)

Weave in ends and you have a new headband!
