




TEMPERATURE BLANKET IN C2C - BABY SIZE





You'll crochet your temperature blanket during one year, from January 1st to December 31st. It's each days temperature that decides which colour you'll crochet with for the different days. Decide when during the day you'll read your thermometer and write it down in the calender below. Use my colour chart or make your own and crochet accordingly to these instructions.

C2C

C2C stands for Corner to Corner which means you'll start crocheting in one corner and finish in the opposite one. If you haven't crochet using C2C before you can find a beginner instruction av my website under Patterns or click here.

How to read the graph?

Each colour, except for the black and white, represents one month. I've tried to distribute an equal amount of squares to each month, below you'll see how many squares to crochet every day. Since the months aren't dividable with the amount of squares you'll have to look closely to see how days you're going to crochet that many squares.

Crochet the black and white squares in just black and white to mark the details in your temperature blanket.

Start reading the graph at the bottom right corner.

Month	Squares	Squares/days
January	528	17 for 30 days - 18 for 1 day
February	547	19 for 13 days - 20 for 15 days
Mars	516	16 for 11 days - 17 for 20 days
April	522	17 for 18 days- 18 for 12 days
May	515	16 for 12 days - 17 for 19 days
June	504	16 for 6 days - 17 for 24 days
July	560	18 for 29 days - 19 for 2 days
August	515	16 for 12 days - 17 for 19 days
September	522	17 for 18 days - 18 for 12 days
October	516	16 for 11 days - 17 for 20 days
November	547	25 for 21 days - 26 for 9 days
December	528	17 for 30 days - 18 for 1 day



Crochet hook: 2,5 mm or 3mm (B or C) **Yarn:** Yarn appropriate to the hooks above Yarn usage: Start with one skein in each colour and then get more when needed. It's hard to know which colours you'll need when you don't know which ones you will be using.

Don't forget 2 skeins of black and 2 skeins of white for the details in the middle.

The blanket is 80x100 squares, when I make baby blankets in this size with hook 3 mm it measures 95x120 cm (37x47 in.). But the size will vary depending on what yarn and hook you use.
