




TEMPERATURE BLANKET IN C2C





You'll crochet your temperature blanket during one year, from January 1st to December 31st. It's each days temperature that decides which colour you'll crochet with for the different days. Decide when during the day you'll read your thermometer and write it down in the calender below. Use my colour chart or make your own and crochet accordingly to these instructions.

C2C

C2C stands for Corner to Corner which means you'll start crocheting in one corner and finish in the opposite one. If you haven't crochet using C2C before you can find a beginner instruction av my website under Patterns or click here.

How to read the graph? Each colour, except for the black and white, represents one

Each colour, except for the black and white, represents one month. I've tried to distribute an equal amount of squares to each month, below you'll see how many squares to crochet every day. Since the months aren't dividable with the amount of squares you'll have to look closely to see how days you're going to crochet that many squares.

Crochet the black and white squares in just black and white to mark the details in your temperature blanket.

Start reading the graph at the bottom right corner.

Crochet hook: 5 mm (H) **Yarn:** Scheepjes Colour Crafter

Yarn usage: Start with one skein in each colour and then get more when needed. It's hard to know which colours you'll need when you don't know which ones you will be using.

Don't forget 2 skeins of black and 2 skeins of white for the details in the middle.

The blanket is 100x130 squares and since I haven't made this blanket size with this yarn before it's hard to give you precise measurments.

My test square 10x10 squares measured 13x13 cm (5x5 in.).

Therefore, I expect the blanket to measure ap. 130x170cm (51x67 in.).
